The parties to this Addendum are Chemeketa Community College (Chemeketa) located at 4000 Lancaster Drive NE, Salem OR 97305, and Oregon Health & Science University-Portland State University (OHSU-PSU) located at 840 SW Gaines Street, Room 230; Portland, OR 97239.

The purpose of this addendum to the articulation and transfer agreement is to extend the term of the agreement for the Applied Health and Fitness program. All terms and conditions established in the agreement signed on February 2018 shall remain. This addendum establishes that the agreement between Chemeketa' Health and Human Performance and OHSU-PSU's School of Public Health is subject to re-evaluation in five years (expiring in June 30, 2023), unless changes and modifications are necessary, or terminated earlier. Continuation and/or modification to this agreement must be provided in writing by Chemeketa to OHSU-PSU's Dean of Public Health and by OHSU-PSU to Chemeketa's Dean of Health and Human Performance, and approved by Chemeketa's Vice President, Instruction and Student Services/Campus President-Yamhill Valley, and PSU's Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs.

#### Identify Both Institutions:

The parties to this Articulation Agreement are Chemeketa Community College (Chemeketa) located at 4000 Lancaster Drive NE, Salem OR 97305, and Oregon Health & Science University-Portland State University (OHSU-PSU) located at 840 SW Gaines Street, Room 230; Portland, OR 97239.

#### Effective Date:

This agreement is effective beginning the 2017 - 2018 academic year, and is subject to an annual re-evaluation by both institutions for continuation and/or modification.

### Purpose/Transfer Agreement:

The purpose of this agreement is to develop, maintain, and promote a smooth academic pathway that supports successful student transition to OHSU-PSU and the Applied Health and Fitness program. This agreement does not guarantee admissions to OHSU-PSU, nor does it carry any other promises, such as financial aid or course placement, unless otherwise noted.

This agreement is based on an evaluation of the rigor and content of the Technical and General Education Courses at both Chemeketa and OHSU-PSU. It is agreed that students transferring from Chemeketa's Health and Human Performance to OHSU-PSU's School of Public Health will be given credit for the courses listed below.

#### Terms of Review/Re-evaluation:

This agreement is subject to annual re-evaluation by both colleges for continuation and/or modification not less than 90 days prior to the end of the academic year. Continuation and/or modification to this agreement must be provided in writing by Chemeketa to OHSU-PSU's Dean of Public Health and by OHSU-PSU to Chemeketa's Dean of Teaching and Learning, and approved by Chemeketa's Vice President, Instruction and Student Services/Campus President-Yamhill Valley, and PSU's Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs.

#### Termination:

Either college can terminate this agreement by providing written notice no less than 90 days prior to the intent to terminate. This notice must be provided by Chemeketa to OHSU-PSU's Dean of Public Health and by OHSU-PSU to Chemeketa's Dean of Teaching and Learning.

No Agency Relationship:

In carrying out the responsibilities and obligations of this Agreement, neither party shall be acting as the agent or principal of the other with regard to dealings with third parties, including students. Neither party shall have the authority to make any statements, representations, nor commitments of any kind or to take any action binding on the other except as provided for herein or authorized in writing by the party to be bound.

Termination Due to Non-Appropriation of Funds:

If sufficient funds are not provided in future legislatively approved budgets of the State of Oregon's Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) (or from applicable Federal, State or other sources) to permit OHSU-PSU in the exercise of its reasonable administrative discretion to continue this Agreement, or if HECC, OHSU-PSU, or any program for which this Agreement was established is abolished, this Agreement may be terminated without further liability by not less than thirty (30) days' written notice to Chemeketa Community College.

No Third Party Beneficiaries:

OHSU-PSU and Chemeketa are the only parties to the Agreement and are the only parties entitled to enforce its terms. Nothing in this Agreement gives, is intended to give, or shall be construed to give or provide, any benefit or right, whether directly, indirectly, or otherwise, to third persons unless such third persons are individually identified by name herein and expressly described as intended beneficiaries of the terms of this Agreement.

Force Majeure:

Any prevention delay or stoppage due to strikes, lockouts, labor disputes, acts of God, inability to obtain labor or materials or reasonable substitutes therefore, governmental restrictions, governmental regulations, governmental controls, enemy or hostile governmental action, terrorism, civil commotion, fire or other casualty, and other causes beyond the reasonable control of the party obligated to perform, shall excuse the performance by such party for a period equal to any prevention, delay or stoppage.

**Execution and Counterparts:** 

This Agreement may be executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be an original, all of which shall constitute but one and the same instrument.

MERGER. THIS AGREEMENT CONSTITUTES THE ENTIRE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PARTIES. NO WAIVER, CONSENT, MODIFICATION, OR CHANGE OF TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BIND EITHER PARTY UNLESS IN WRITING AND SIGNED BY BOTH PARTIES. SUCH WAIVER CONSENT, MODIFICATION, OR CHANGE, IF MADE, SHALL BE EFFECTIVE ONLY IN THE SPECIFIC INSTANCE AND FOR THE SPECIFIC PURPOSE GIVEN. THERE ARE NO UNDERSTANDINGS, AGREEMENTS OR REPRESENTATIONS, ORAL OR WRITTEN, NOT SPECIFIED HEREIN REGARDING THIS AGREEMENT.
