




## Linfield Wine Studies Transfer/Pathway Agreement

It is in the interest of both Chemeketa and Linfield to facilitate the transfer of qualified students from Chemeketa's Winemaking Associate of Applied Science (AAS) program to Linfield's Bachelor of Science (BS) or Bachelor of Arts (BA) Wine Studies program.



## **Linfield Wine Studies Transfer/Pathway Agreement with Chemeketa Community College**

This transfer agreement, named Linfield Wine Studies Transfer/Pathway Agreement (LWSTPA), is entered into and by and between Linfield University (Linfield) and Chemeketa Community College (Chemeketa).

It is in the interest of both Chemeketa and Linfield to facilitate the transfer of qualified students from Chemeketa's Winemaking Associate of Applied Science (AAS) program to Linfield's Bachelor of Science (BS) or Bachelor of Arts (BA) Wine Studies program.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties for good and sufficient consideration agree as follows:

Linfield agrees to accept credits for students transferring from Chemeketa to Linfield, as outlined in the Transfer Pathways in Exhibits A and B, which are hereby incorporated and made part of this agreement.

### **Terms and Conditions:**

- 1. Term Termination:** This agreement shall be considered approved by both parties on the date of the last signature and the program will commence on August 25, 2025, and shall terminate on June 30th, 2028, unless terminated earlier as provided herein. This agreement shall be effective for students who apply to transfer from Chemeketa to Linfield beginning with Linfield's Fall Semester of 2025. This agreement may be renewed for additional terms of any length by the mutual written agreement of the parties. Either party may terminate or suspend this Agreement for convenience upon sixty (60) days written notice; provided, however, that the parties shall discuss and reasonable attempt to resolve the issues that led to the notice of termination or suspension during the sixty (60) day period. Notwithstanding the termination of this Agreement, any students who have been accepted for transfer from Chemeketa to Linfield prior or during the sixty (60) day period shall be treated

as if this Agreement continues to be in effect. This Agreement may also be terminated as provided elsewhere in this Agreement.

**2. Admissions:** Admission to Linfield is not guaranteed. Students shall apply for admission in accordance with Linfield's existing rules, policies, and procedures.

**3. General Provisions:**

- a. Academic Alignment: Prescriptive transfer pathways will be maintained and updated as necessary by Linfield and Chemeketa.
- b. Academic Record Sharing: Chemeketa agrees to share academic records with Linfield for any student who has indicated they are part of the LWSPTA. In order to participate, students from Chemeketa must sign a FERPA waiver that will grant Chemeketa permission to share transcripts quarterly with Linfield. In addition to transcripts, Chemeketa also agrees to share whether an LWSPTA student has met their required transfer advising appointments at Chemeketa.
- c. Financial Assistance: Linfield will offer a combination of grants and scholarships from federal, state of Oregon, and Linfield sources, to contribute to the cost of attendance for students transferring from Chemeketa to Linfield. For Linfield-sponsored financial assistance, eligible students will have a 2.5 minimum Cumulative GPA and have completed 45 transferable quarter credits (30 semester credits). Transfer scholarships are based on merit and are made on an individual student basis, the Linfield Net Price Calculator displays the amount an individual student can expect: <https://www.linfield.edu/financial-aid/net-price-calculator-transfer.html>.

Up to five (5) students who major in Wine Studies at Linfield University will be considered for an additional \$5,000 per student per year scholarship from the Wine Studies department. Eligible students will have financial need as determined by FAFSA, with preference given to first generation students. All Linfield-funded scholarships are automatically renewable so long as the student maintains full-time enrollment, makes satisfactory academic progress, and maintains their eligibility to receive financial aid. Students who matriculate at Linfield after completing Chemeketa's Winemaking Associate of Applied Science (AAS) program will be eligible for financial aid through six (6) full-time semesters on enrollment at Linfield while pursuing a Baccalaureate degree.

- d. Requirements: Students must complete an AAS degree in Winemaking with a minimum of 2.5 GPA before matriculation at Linfield.
- e. Campus Engagement: Students who are on the LWSPTA will have the opportunity to engage in a variety of social and extracurricular activities on the Linfield campus.
- f. Programmatic Transfer Advising: Students on the LWSPTA will be expected to meet with their transfer advisor at Chemeketa twice a year while at Chemeketa to ensure they are on track to transfer to Linfield under this agreement. After matriculation at Linfield, students will be required to meet with a Linfield Academic Advisor each semester before registering for courses to ensure they are on track to meet the program requirements.
- g. Transfer Cohorts: LWSPTA students will follow a cohort model at Linfield unless otherwise approved by the department chair.
- h. Cross-Registration: With the approval of the registrars from both institutions, students enrolled full-time (12-credit minimum) in the Winemaking program at Chemeketa Community College or in the Wine Studies program at Linfield may take a maximum of one on-campus undergraduate course per semester at the other institution with no additional tuition, if the course is applicable toward their Wine program at their home institution. Students are responsible for all applicable course fees. Scheduling and transportation are student responsibilities. Details are available from the registrar's office at each campus.
- i. Promotion: Chemeketa and Linfield will promote this transfer agreement and major pathways on their individual websites and other promotional materials.


- b. No Third-Party Beneficiaries. Linfield and Chemeketa are the only parties to this agreement and the only parties entitled to enforce its terms.
