

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Klamath Community College
Practical Nursing Program

to

Chemeketa Community College
Nursing Program

Identify Both Institutions:

The parties to this Articulation Agreement are Chemeketa Community College (Chemeketa) located at 4000 Lancaster Drive NE, Salem OR 97305, and Klamath Community College (KCC) located at 7390 S. 6th Street, Klamath Falls, OR 97603.

Effective Date:

This agreement is effective beginning the Fall quarter, 2021 academic year, and is subject to an annual re-evaluation by both institutions for continuation and/or modification.

Purpose/Transfer Agreement:

This agreement is based on an evaluation of the rigor and content of the general education and nursing program courses at both KCC and Chemeketa. It is agreed that students transferring from KCC's Practical Nursing program to Chemeketa's Associate Degree Nursing program will be given credit for the courses listed below.

KCC students are required to follow Chemeketa's admissions and application guidelines. In addition, KCC students would be required to take PSY 201M from KCC or equivalent course to PSY 201 at Chemeketa. KCC students could also take PSY 201A and PSY 202A (PSY 201 & PSY 202 at Chemeketa) in order to fulfill our credit requirements for the ADN

KCC students will meet with the Dean of Health Sciences to evaluate their transcripts after completion of all their general education courses. The potential student will receive additional course requirement information and Kaplan Transition Testing information. Once the additional courses are successfully completed and the Kaplan test is complete with a 77% or higher the student will be put on the programs waitlist for a potential seat in the second year of the nursing program as an LPN to RN Transfer student. Acceptance into the program is based on seat availability per the ranking system. This articulation agreement does not guarantee KCC student placement into the second year of the Chemeketa Nursing program.

Terms of Review/Re-evaluation:

This agreement is subject to annual re-evaluation by both colleges for continuation and/or modification not less than 90 days prior to the end of the academic year. Continuation and/or modification to this agreement must be provided in writing by Chemeketa to the Director of Nursing at KCC and by KCC to Chemeketa's Dean of Health Sciences, and approved by Chemeketa's Vice President of Academic Affairs and [insert institution's name and appropriate title].

Termination:

Either college can terminate this agreement by providing written notice no less than 90 days prior to the intent to terminate. This notice must be provided by Chemeketa to the Director of Nursing at KCC, and by KCC to Chemeketa's Dean of Health Sciences.






