

# ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Chemeketa Community College  
Education Program

to

Linfield University  
Teacher Education Program

## Identify Both Institutions:

The parties to this Articulation Agreement are Chemeketa Community College (Chemeketa) located at 4000 Lancaster Drive NE, Salem OR 97305, and Linfield University (Linfield) located at 900 SE Baker St., McMinnville, Oregon 97128.

## Effective Date:

This agreement is effective beginning the 2021/2022 academic year for two years, and thereafter is subject to re-evaluation by both institutions for continuation and/or modification as needed.

## Purpose/Transfer Agreement:

This agreement is based on an evaluation of the rigor and content of the Education Courses at both Chemeketa and Linfield. It is agreed that students transferring from Chemeketa's Education Department to Linfield's Education Department will be given credit for the courses listed below. This agreement also mirrors the Oregon Transfer Compass for Elementary Education.

Chemeketa students are encouraged to refer to the *Linfield University Education Major Transfer Guide* (which can be found on Chemeketa's Education Department website).

In addition to courses listed above, Chemeketa students will complete an AAOT with Elementary Education emphasis.

Chemeketa students are required to follow Linfield admissions and application guidelines.

To be admitted into the Linfield Education Program, candidates must maintain a 2.75 GPA (cumulative, major, and licensure), and hold no grades lower than a C in Education coursework.

**Requirements distinguishing Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Science degrees.**

Bachelor of Arts (BA) candidates must satisfy a foreign language requirement by successfully completing 8 semester credits in one language at the elementary level, 5 credits of an intensive elementary-level language course, or a one semester language course at or above 201.

Bachelor of Science (BS) candidates must successfully complete two courses of at least 3 semester credits each in a single field from anthropology, biology, chemistry, computer science, economics, environmental studies, mathematics, physics, political science, psychology or sociology. These courses must be outside of the major department and in addition to the Linfield Education Curriculum.

**Terms of Review/Re-evaluation:**

This agreement is subject to biannual re-evaluation by both colleges for continuation and/or modification not less than 90 days prior to the end of the academic year. Continuation and/or modification of this agreement must be provided in writing by Chemeketa to Linfield University Director of Education and by Linfield to Chemeketa's Dean of Education and approved by Chemeketa's Vice President of Academic Affairs.


**Termination:**

Either college can terminate this agreement by providing written notice no less than 90 days prior to the intent to terminate. This notice must be provided by Chemeketa to Linfield's Director of Education, and by Linfield to Chemeketa's Vice President of Academic Affairs.




