



Transfer Articulation Agreement

Between Chemeketa Community College and Warner Pacific University

Warner Pacific University's RN to BSN program is designed to provide upper division coursework leading to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree to students who already hold RN licensure and an associate degree from an accredited institution. The program will prepare nurses for positions of leadership, and will provide education and training in person-centered care beyond a patient's immediate physical needs. Care management, transitions of care, organizational leadership and communication, culturally competent care, and nursing at the levels of family, community and population are considered through a lens of Christ-centered social justice.

This articulation agreement between Chemeketa Community College (CCC) and Warner Pacific University (WP) is intended to develop, maintain, and promote a smooth academic pathway that supports successful student transition from CCC's Associate of Applied Science (AAS) in Nursing to the completion of the WP RN to BSN degree program.

RN to BSN ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

CCC's AAS in Nursing graduates must meet the regular admission requirements for WP as listed in the Professional and Graduate Studies (PGS) Bulletin. Applicants to WP's RN to BSN program are also required to demonstrate:

- Completion of the following pre-nursing requirements with a "C-" or higher:
 - Human Anatomy & Physiology series (not introductory)
 - 1 course in Microbiology with lab (recommended)
- Successful completion of CCC's AAS in Nursing degree
- Possession of a current unencumbered RN license
- A cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 in all previous college-level coursework

GENERAL EDUCATION CORE REQUIREMENTS for RN to BSN GRADUATES

CCC students must complete the following General Education Core requirements as an integral component of their BSN degree. The requirements may be completed as part of their AAS program at CCC, as general electives taken outside of the AAS program, or at WP, in addition to the RN to BSN program coursework:

- English Composition course, (e.g. WR 121, completed with a grade of C- or higher). Must be completed prior to entering the RN to BSN program.

RN to BSN PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

WP's 43-credit RN to BSN program is offered in an accelerated, cohort-based degree format. The format is intentionally designed to assure student achievement of program outcomes, and to incorporate General Education Core requirements that specifically enhance the training of the BSN candidates:

Completion of WP's BSN requires:

1. Successful fulfillment of all General Education Core requirements as noted on page 1 and above (HUM 310A, REL 310A, and REL 320A).
2. Completion of all RN to BSN cohort coursework, earning at least a C- in all "NURS" prefix courses
3. Completion of at least 124 semester credits with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0




